**1. What Makes Revivals IMPOSSIBLE?**

**They come through ordinary people**

*Jonah went to Ninevah (vs 3)*

**They come where they're least expected**

*Ninevah, that great city (vs 2)*

**They come by the preaching of God's word**

*Call out against it the message that I tell you (vs 2)*

**2. What Makes Revivals INCREDIBLE?**

**Worldly people became godly**

*The people of Ninevah believed God (vs 5)*

**Proud people became humble**

*They called for a fast and put on sackcloth (vs 5)*

**Violent people became compassionate**

*Let everyone turn from his evil way and from violence (vs 8)*

*Everyone who calls upon  
the name of the Lord  
shall be saved.*

*In the name of Jesus,  
rise up and walk!*
