## **WEEK 3**

### **Sunday: 2/14**

#### **Read:**

*1 Peter 1* -- Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,<sup>4</sup> to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you,<sup>5</sup> who by God's power are being guarded through faith for a salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.

#### **Pray:**

1. for seekers and cynics who will be in worship with us: that the Lord will meet them and draw them to himself
2. for those who will be leading in worship

#### **Prayer based on 1 Peter 2:11-12:**

Father I ask that you would allow me, as an alien and stranger in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against my soul. Help me to live such a good life among unbelievers that they might see my good deeds and glorify you.

### **Monday: 2/15**

#### **Read:**

*1 Peter 1* -- And if you call on him as Father who judges impartially according to each one's deeds, conduct yourselves with fear throughout the time of your exile,<sup>18</sup> knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold,<sup>19</sup> but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot.<sup>20</sup> He was foreknown before the foundation of the world but was made manifest in the last times for your sake,<sup>21</sup> who through him are believers in God, who raised him from the dead and gave him glory, so that your faith and hope are in God.<sup>22</sup> Having purified your souls by your obedience to the truth for a sincere brotherly love, love one another earnestly from a pure heart,<sup>23</sup> since you have been born again, not of perishable seed but of imperishable, through the living and abiding word of God;

#### **Pray:**

1. Glorify God for something specific he has done in your life (some tangible way you see Him working)
2. for God to bring someone into your life that you can share your faith with, and the courage to do so

**Prayer based on 1 Peter 2:11-12:**

Father I ask that you would allow me, as an alien and stranger in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against my soul. Help me to live such a good life among unbelievers that they might see my good deeds and glorify you.

**Tuesday: 2/16**

**Read:**

*1 Peter 2* -- But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.<sup>10</sup> Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.<sup>11</sup> Beloved, I urge you as sojourners and exiles to abstain from the passions of the flesh, which wage war against your soul.<sup>12</sup> Keep your conduct among the Gentiles honorable, so that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may see your good deeds and glorify God on the day of visitation.

**Pray:**

1. for Oasis Compassion Ministry (a local ministry that helps people get back on their feet through job training, food, etc)
2. for our ESL program (volunteers, students, opportunities to share the gospel)

**Prayer based on 1 Peter 2:11-12:**

Father I ask that you would allow me, as an alien and stranger in the world, to abstain from sinful desires, which war against my soul. Help me to live such a good life among unbelievers that they might see my good deeds and glorify you.

**Wednesday: 2/17**

**Read:**

*1 Peter 4* -- Therefore, since Christ suffered in his body, arm yourselves also with the same attitude, because he who has suffered in his body is done with sin.<sup>2</sup> As a result, he does not live the rest of his earthly life for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God.<sup>3</sup> For you have spent enough time in the past doing what pagans choose to do-- living in debauchery, lust, drunkenness, orgies, carousing and detestable idolatry.<sup>4</sup> They think it

strange that you do not plunge with them into the same flood of dissipation, and they heap abuse on you.<sup>5</sup> But they will have to give account to him who is ready to judge the living and the dead.<sup>6</sup> For this is the reason the gospel was preached even to those who are now dead, so that they might be judged according to men in regard to the body, but live according to God in regard to the spirit.<sup>7</sup> The end of all things is near. Therefore be clear minded and self-controlled so that you can pray.<sup>8</sup> Above all, love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.<sup>9</sup> Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.<sup>10</sup> Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms.<sup>11</sup> If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God. If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.

1. for God to give you a spirit willing to show hospitality to others and to keep you from a spirit that wants to entertain, but rather to serve (see v.9)
2. for the opportunity to use your gifts to serve the church here at LOPC and the Kingdom of God at large (see v.10)

**Saturday: 2/20**

**Read:**

*Acts 2* – <sup>14</sup>Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd: "Fellow Jews and all of you who live in Jerusalem, let me explain this to you; listen carefully to what I say.

<sup>22</sup>"Men of Israel, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him, as you yourselves

know.<sup>23</sup> This man was handed over to you by God's set purpose and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to the cross.<sup>24</sup> But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death, because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him.<sup>25</sup> David said about him: "'I saw the Lord always before me.
